8 Don't ever be ashamed, then, of the testimony about our Lord or of me, His prisoner, but partner with me in suffering hardship for the gospel, according to the power of God 9 who rescued us and called us with a holy calling—not based on any doings of ours but based on His own purpose and grace, a *grace* given to us in Christ Jesus before time began, 10 but now made plain through the appearing of our Savior Christ Jesus, who destroyed death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel, 11 of which I was appointed a herald and an apostle and a teacher 12 —and that's why even I am suffering as I do. Yet I'm not ashamed, because I know the One in whom I've placed my trust, and I stand convinced that He's able to guard the treasure I've entrusted to Him, until "that day." ♦
