8 Keep Jesus Christ constantly before your mind, raised from the dead, descended from David—that's my gospel, 9 for which I suffer hardship, even to the point of being shackled as a criminal (yet God's word is not shackled!) 10 That's why I keep enduring all that I do for the sake of the elect, so that they too may obtain the salvation that is in Christ Jesus, together with eternal glory. 11 The saying is certain:
If we've died with Him, we'll also live with Him.
12 If we continue to endure, we'll also reign with Him.
If we will disown Him, He'll also disown us.
13 If we are faithless, He remains faithful, because He can't disown Himself. ♦
