3 But sexual immorality and any-and-all impurity and greed must not even be named among you, as is proper among saints, 4 and there must be no filthiness nor foolish talk nor crude joking, which are out of place, but instead there should be thanksgiving. 5 For you may be sure of this, that everyone who is sexually immoral or impure or greedy (that is, an idolater) has no inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and God. 6 Let no one deceive you with empty words, for because of these things God's wrath comes upon the sons of disobedience. 7 Therefore stop associating with them; 8 for at one time you were darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light 9 (for the fruit of light is found in all that is good and right and true), 10 and try to discern what will please the Lord. 11 Take no part in the unfruitful works of darkness, but instead actually expose them, 12 for it is shameful even to speak of the things they do in secret; 13 but when anything is exposed by the light, it becomes visible, 14 for anything that becomes visible is light. Therefore it says, "Awake, sleeper, and rise from the dead, and Christ will shine on you." ♦
